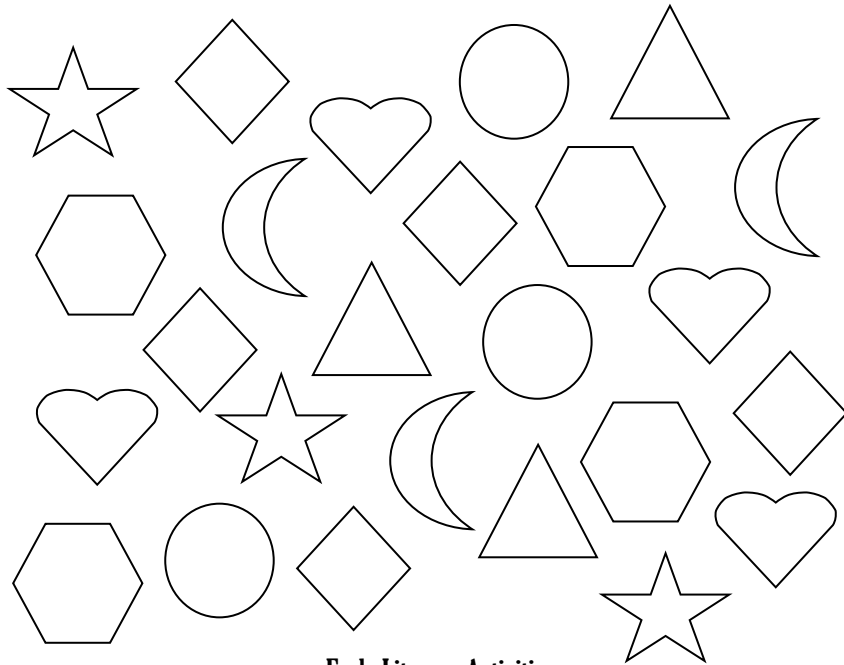


## Level 1-25

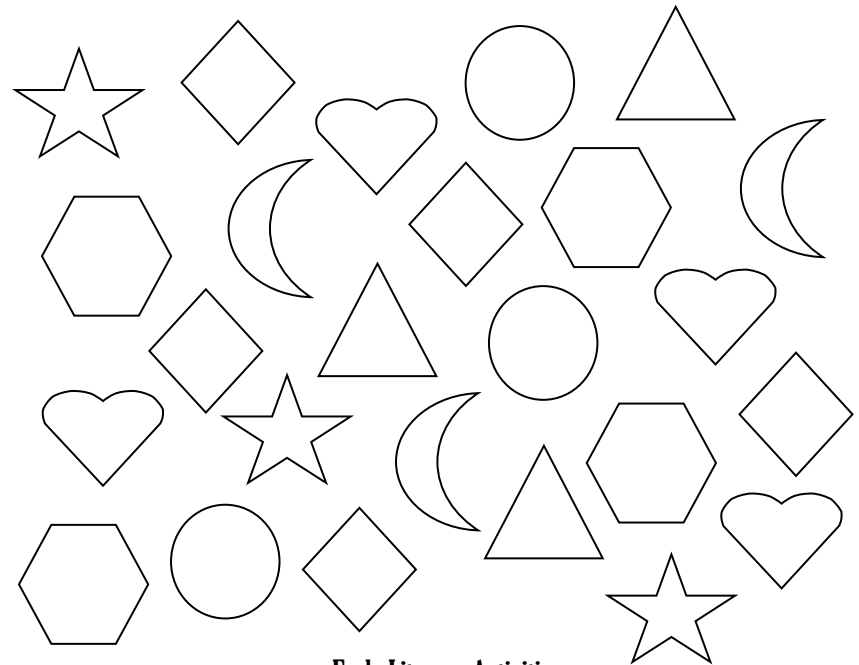


Early Literacy Activities

- Visit the library
- Sing a new song
- Dance to a favorite song
- Recite a nursery rhyme (check Juvenile Nonfiction 398.8 for ideas)
- Do an action rhyme (Itsy Bitsy Spider, Pat-a-Cake, etc.)

## Level 26-50

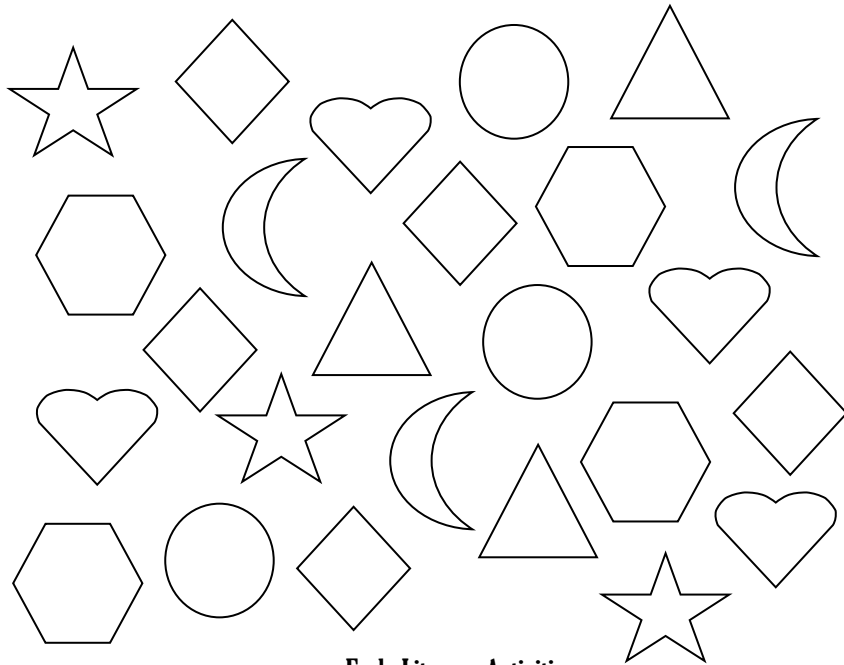


Early Literacy Activities

- Recite a poem (check Juvenile Nonfiction 811 for ideas)
- Do a sensory activity (play with sand, water, etc.)
- Encourage your child to doodle and scribble
- Play peek-a-boo
- Play ball

## Level 51-75

### Early Literacy Activities

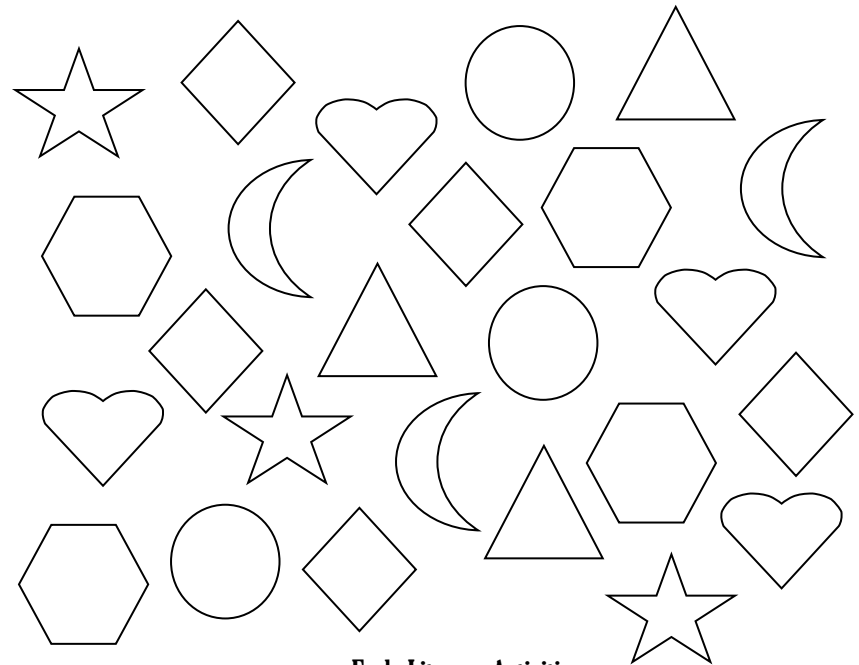
- Play with bubbles together
- Make funny faces with your baby. Let them touch your face and take in your features!
- Make a new sound and see if baby imitates you. This encourages language development!
- Tell a story without a book. Babies find the voice of a caregiver calming and soothing.
- Make up songs with baby's name in them. ("This is the way we change Jill's diaper...so early in the morning.")

## Level 76-100

### Early Literacy Activities

- Use a large bin or basket for toys. Encourage baby to fill the bin & then dump it!
- Visit the park
- Spend some time cuddling (Yes, this promotes literacy!)
- Have fun with flashlights (Babies will learn to visually track the light. Visual tracking is a skill children will use when they have to follow words on a page!)
- Put a handful of books in front of baby and let him or her choose which to read
