

## Craft 'n Things June 2021: Pocket Fans

### Supplies:

- 6x6in pieces of origami paper (3)
- Popsicle Sticks (2)
- Glue Stick
- Ruler (Optional)
- Pencil (Optional)

### Instructions:

1. Take each piece of origami paper and measure out a half inch making a mark at each end of the paper. Then fold at the half inch mark and continue to fold so the paper looks like an accordion. Do this for each piece of paper.
2. Take a piece of the now accordion style paper and fold it in half so it looks like the letter "V.". Do this for each piece of paper.
3. Grab your glue stick and glue the middle of the folds together. It should look like you have three mini-fans.
4. Next, glue each of those three fans together to become one big fan.
5. Now, you will need to glue the popsicle sticks to each side of the fan. Place glue on either side of the fan. Place the popsicle sticks so the longer side is sticking up past the top of the fan. The bottom of the popsicle sticks should be in line with the bottom of the fan where the three folds meet.
6. That's it you now have a pocket fan that you can open and close and use when needed.
